The predecessor to FPCM was the **Horseshoe Bottom Presbyterian Church**. It was located 2 1/2 miles outside of the City of Monongahela in Carroll Township. The church building was demolished but the adjoining church cemetery still exists and is one of the oldest in the Monongahela area.
